

Know Your Risks

Learn your risk of heart attack by
having a CT Calcium Score Screening

CT Calcium Score or Heart Scan, utilizes a low-dose CT scan to measure calcium in coronary arteries. The scan helps indicate atherosclerosis or coronary artery disease (CAD). The information from this exam can help determine if you are at an increased risk for a heart attack and aid in management to reduce cardiovascular events.

This screening is intended for those with:

- Strong family history
- Current or history of smoking
- High blood pressure
 - Diabetes
 - Overweight
- High cholesterol

Screening Cost is \$49

*Amount to be paid at the time of screening. Insurance will not be billed for this screening.
Any follow-up appointments or procedures will be billed to insurance.*

Prior to Screening:

- An order from a primary care provider is required
- Participants must avoid caffeine for four hours
- An appointment time must be scheduled
